

Minutes of Bull Bay Golf Club Ltd Executive Committee Meeting
25.07.2023 Held at Bull Bay Golf Club.

Complaint Hearing.

The Secretary informed the meeting that a complaint had been made to him concerning the behaviour of a Club member towards one of the Club's staff. In accordance with the Club's Articles of Association the letter was signed by five full members.

The member concerned, who is currently under suspension from the Club, and his representative and three of the five complainants attended the meeting. Both the member concerned and the complainants gave their full representations to the Executive Committee and were then asked to leave the meeting in order for the Executive Committee to give due consideration to both arguments.

A full and frank discussion took place amongst the Executive Committee and its conclusion was that the member concerned should be expelled from the Club with immediate effect. The decision of the Executive Committee was unanimous.

The Secretary was instructed to advise both parties in writing of the decision the Executive Committee had made.

Given the time taken on the complaint issue captain decided that the only item for discussion in this meeting would be our forthcoming Open week.

Open Week.

NM advised that the Ladies section would hold a presentation every evening during the week. Captain reported that a presentation would

be held on the evening of 30th July for the H R Owen Trophy, The Ty Croes Cup and the overall Town Cup. A further presentation would take place on Friday 4th August for all other competitions taking place during the week. He also advised that a full presentation for all other competitions held since the start of the golfing year would be held on the evening of the Champion of Champions competition scheduled for Saturday 23rd September.

NM reported that she had received feedback that the cost of entry to our Open events was too high and discouraging people from entering. PF suggested that we conduct a year on year analysis to compare entry levels. He also suggested the formation of a sub committee to begin preparation now for next year's Open week to plan and also to attract sponsorship of events.

LG advised that the course was in the process of receiving a revised slope rating and that stroke allowances be calculated from the information on the Wales Golf app. He also advised it is a requirement to sign in for entry for Open competitions. LG was complimented by TY for the information pack he had circulated about Open week. This was endorsed by the whole Committee.

Any Other Business/Unrhyw Fater Arall:-

JT reported that Jamie Donaldson was happy to continue with his contribution to the Pro Am and we should endeavour to make it a bigger and better event. He also advised that Anglesey Mining had agreed to sponsor again next year at a higher rate of contribution. TY asked if we could publicise revised Captain's Day date and any entertainment happening on the day. Marketing agreed to action this. TS advised that Golf Mates which is an influential YouTube channel carrying out ratings and reviews on golf courses would be visiting in early August and could we have the course well presented on the day. PF would ensure that this happened.

LG reported that the 1

st August E Humphreys competition would be set up to accommodate two tees, yellow and white. Entrants playing off the white tees could win the trophy, whilst entrants off the yellow tees would compete for the vouchers.

Captain closed the meeting at 8.25pm.
